Blanchland Moor Off Piste Use – signage project

Brief:

Working in partnership with the local land management organisations to position information signs. The main aim to discourage off piste driving and riding on land adjacent to the byway across Blanchland moor, Northumberland. Following meetings with the local gamekeeper we obtained his support to supply and install these signs. We have also liaised with local Police and offered our full support in tackling this illegal activity. Together with the gamekeeper we will monitor the situation to gauge the effectiveness of the signs. Whilst on site our member, who is also a volunteer with 4x4 Response North East, assisted with identification of a landing site for the North East Air Ambulance.
