Brief:

The local parish have a large percentage of byways which are well used (if not overused) and a small selection of other rights of way which were poorly signed and with dilapidated stiles and gates.

The first part of the project was helping waymark, erecting a couple of bridleway sign,s and removing foliage around several existing signs. We have also been involved with Parish Council rights of way meetings about how they can improve access for all.
