#### Consider:

- ➤ your personal situation - are you or any of household family members in the 'at risk' group?
- think about others. Many people will still want to maintain a considerable social distance.

## Think:

- Travel only with
  household members in
  your vehicle, and no
  more than six people in
  your group.
- Keep groups small a maximum of three vehicles (based on two people per vehicle).
- **➤ avoid busy routes**, and be courteous.

## Stay safe:

- maintain social distancing - stay 1m apart from those outside your household, but 2m is preferable.
- keep clean use gloves/sanitizer/wash your hands, as appropriate when necessary.
- stick to routes you know in order to avoid unexpected problems, or get advice from our rea reps.

## **Check:**

- with the local authority if you have any concerns or questions.
- ➤ that your vehicle is in a good state of repair.
- that your route is legal, but consider that some residential areas may still be concerned.

## Remember:

- ➤ plan your route around these restrictions, not all facilities maybe open.
- there have been illegal obstructions on RoWs during lockdown report them to the local authority and your area rep. Do not abate unless you're sure it is legal and safe to do so.
